of in this will be sold at my death and
the proceeds thereof equally divided among
my lawful heirs. Excepting my son J. J.
King Jr. who shall have of this fund twenty dollars only.

4th I will That Susan Candis King shall have the sum of six Hundred Dollars of the money derived from the sale & proceeds of the Eighty acres of Land lying North of the so called King Road

This money to be cared for by her Guardian untill she becomes of age or Marries

5th I will That my Wife Catharine King have all the House hold & Kitchen furniture now on hand together with all the farming utensils Tractors Plows Harrows &c with Three Head of good farm Horses with all the cows & Hogs now on the farm

6th It is my Will That my Wife Catharine King be my lawful Executrix to settle up all my business

I further authorize her to choose any one to assist her whom she may see proper signed & sealed in presence of

7th I will That my ~~son~~ ^{daughter} King have one Hundred Dollars out of this money ^{in full} ~~for her~~ ^{for her}

ADMITTED TO RECORD.

On this 25 day of April, 1868, the last Will and Testament of Jesse King late of Mercer County deceased, was produced in Court, and J. M. Price and Lewis Martin the subscribing witnesses to said Will appeared, and in open Court, on oath testified to the due execution of said Will, which testimony was reduced to writing and by them respectively subscribed and filed with said Will; and it appearing to the Court by said testimony that said Will was duly attested and executed and that the said Testator, at the time of executing the same was of full age, and of sound mind and memory and not under any restraint: It is ordered by the Court that said Will and testimony be recorded.

And thereupon came Catharine King the Executrix in said Will named and accepted said Trust

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER ORDERED, that Letters Testamentary be issued to her on her giving bonds in the sum of \$8000 Dollars. And thereupon the said Catharine King appeared in open Court and accepted said appointment and gave bonds, conditioned according to law with J. M. Price William King & Lewis Martin his securities. Catharine King widow of said Jesse King in open Court signified her acceptance of the provisions made for her in said Will in lieu of dower.
