King jr he shall have of this fund twenty dollars only

4th I will That Susan Sanders King shall have the sum of Six Hundred Dollars of the money derived from the sale & proceeds of the Eighty acres of Land lying North of the so called King Road

This money to be cared for by her Guardian untill she becomes of age or Marries

5th I will That my Wife Catharine King have all the House hold & Kitchen furniture now on hand together with all the farming utensils Tragsons Polows Harrows &c with Three Head of good farm Horses with all the cows & Hogs now on the farm

6th It is my Will That my Wife Catharine King be my lawful Exeratrix to settle up all my business

I further authorize her to choose any one to assist her whom she may see proper signed & sealed in presence of

7th I will That my ~~son~~ ^{Wife} Catharine King have one ~~third~~ ^{share} out of ~~his~~ ^{her} money ~~and~~ ^{and} ~~land~~ ^{land}

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

ADMITTED TO RECORD.

Jesse King

On this 25 day of April, 1868, the last Will and Testament of Jesse King late of Mercer County deceased, was produced in Court, and J. M. Price and Lewis Marts the subscribing witnesses to said Will appeared, and in open Court, on oath testified to the due execution of said Will, which testimony was reduced to writing and by them respectively subscribed and filed with said Will; and it appearing to the Court by said testimony that said Will was duly attested and executed and that the said Testator, at the time of executing the same was of full age, and of sound mind and memory and not under any restraint: It is ordered by the Court that said Will and testimony be recorded.

And thereupon came Catharine King the Executrix in said Will named and accepted said Trust

IT IS THEREFORE FURTHER ORDERED, that Letters Testamentary be issued to her on her giving bonds in the sum of \$8000 Dollars. And thereupon the said Catharine King appeared in open Court and accepted said appointment and gave bonds, conditioned according to law with J. M. Price William King & Lewis Marts his securities. Catharine King widow of said Jesse King in open Court signified her acceptance of the provisions made for her in said Will in lieu of dower.

EXECUTOR'S BOND.

No. 37

Know all Men by these Presents, That we Catharine King as principal and J. M. Paine M. King and Lewis Marks as sureties, of the County of Mercer in the State of Ohio, are held and firmly bound to the State of Ohio in the penal sum of Eight Thousand Dollars, to the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made to said State of Ohio, we do bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated the 25th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight.

The condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bound Catharine King Executrix of the last Will and Testament of Jesse King deceased, late of Black Creek Sp in the County of Mercer aforesaid:

First, shall make and return to the Probate Court, within and for said County, on oath, within three months, a true inventory of all the moneys, goods, chattels, rights and credits of the testator which are by law to be administered, and which shall have come to her possession or knowledge; and also, if required by said Court, an inventory of the real estate of the deceased.

Second, That she shall administer according to law and to the Will of the testator all his goods, chattels, rights and credits, and the proceeds of all his real estate that may be sold for the payment of his debts or legacies, which shall at any time come to her possession, or to the possession of any other person for her; and

Third, Shall render upon oath, a just and true account of her administration within eighteen months, and at any other time when required by said Court or the law; and failing so to do, for thirty days after she shall have been notified of the expiration of the time, by the Probate Judge, she shall receive no allowances for services, unless the Court shall enter upon its journal that such delay was necessary and reasonable, then this obligation to be void: otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law.
